Winter Facility Rules

Changing conditions exist. Under Colorado Law, the Big Mine Ice Rink and the Town of Crested Butte ASSUME NO RESPONSIBILITY AND DO NOT INCUR ANY LIABILITY for any personal injury, loss or damage to users or spectators of the Ice Rink.

Parents and guardians are responsible for their minor's safety and for ensuring their minors comply with the rules and regulations.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Observe and obey all posted signs at all times.
- **Nobody** is allowed on the ice when the Zamboni gate is open, even if the machine is off the ice.
- Skates only on the ice. No sleds, strollers, or street shoes allowed.
- Stay off sun-shield paper and do not move the cones.
- HELMETS REQUIRED if there are pucks on the ice. Helmets and additional pads are always recommended.
- No food or beverages allowed on the ice. No glass allowed in Big Mine Park.
- No animals allowed.
- No smoking allowed.
- No alcohol allowed.
- Use not permitted past 10:00 pm.
- The municipality reserves the right to revoke facility privileges from anyone at any time.

ADDITIONAL HOCKEY RULES

- All players must be registered with USA Hockey prior to setting a blade on the ice.
- The Town of Crested Butte Parks & Recreation Department and all hockey participants and/or spectators must abide by USA Hockey Rules and Regulations at all times.
- Only registered players and coaches for the current game are permitted in the team bench areas.
- Spectators must be outside of the rink at all times. No spectators are permitted in player boxes.
- Do not sit on doors.

VENDOR RULES

- Any business/vendor providing a service or good must comply with the most up to date town code which can be found at www.townofcrestedbutte.com
- All vendors and/or service providers must have a current Town of Crested Butte business license. Business License information can be viewed online. For additional assistance call 970-349-5338.
- All vendors and/or service providers must have current liability insurance. A certificate stating "The Town of Crested Butte" as additional insured must be on file with the Parks & Recreation Department.
