Child Drop Off and Pick Up Policy

- Children cannot be dropped off at a program earlier than 15 minutes prior to the start of activity.
- Parents and legal guardians are the only ones authorized to pick up a child.
 - Children cannot be released to an unauthorized adult.
 - Administrators must be notified in writing if anyone else is eligible to pick up the child
- Children must be picked up on time.
 - A \$15 fee may be assessed for every 15 minutes parents are late, rounded to the nearest 15 minutes.
 - After 15 minutes, coaches or instructors will call the parent or guardian. If they are unable to make contact, the child’s emergency contact will be notified.
 - After 30 minutes, the child will be brought to Town Hall or the Crested Butte Marshalls office for supervision until parent contact can be made.
- Repeated violations of the Pick-up policy may warrant limited participation in future programs.
