## **COVID-19 Stay Home/ Return Policy**

**This set of policies intends to guide parents/guardians of youth recreation program participants and prevent the continued spread of COVID-19 and other illness in our community.**

- 1) If your child is sick/ or showing any symptoms of COVID-19 they are not allowed to attend rec programs
  - a) Signs and Symptoms of COVID-19 include:
    - i) Fever or chills
    - ii) Temp 100.4
    - iii) Loss of taste or smell
    - iv) New or unexplained cough
    - v) Shortness of breath
    - vi) Difficulty breathing
    - vii) Sore throat
    - viii) Runny nose
    - ix) Congestion
    - x) Muscle or body aches
    - xi) Headache
    - xii) Fatigue
    - xiii) Nausea/vomiting/diarrhea
- 2) If your child had a known exposure to an individual who tested positive for COVID-19; they are not allowed to attend rec programs.
- 3) If your child was sent home from school due to an exposure; they are not allowed to attend rec programs.
- 4) Your child may return to their rec program after an exposure:
  - a) If they produce a negative test 5-7 days after the exposure and show no symptoms
  - b) If they receive guidance from the county stating that it is safe for them to do so.
  - c) When they are allowed to return to school.
